1	Professor David Martin	<p>Prof. David Martin is an expert in domestic and international technology transfer and in patent enforcement and issuance. He is the founding CEO of M-CAM, a Charlottesville, Virginia, corporation that developed and commercialized the world's first intellectual property characterization and monetization technology. In the 1990s, he created the first collateral enhancement products that allow regulated financial institutions to use intangible assets as collateral in commercial credit. Dr Martin has been an assistant professor at the University of Virginia's School of Medicine, where he founded and was executive director of the school's first for-profit R&D corporation. In 1999, Dr Martin was appointed by the governor of Virginia to serve on the Joint Commission on Technology and Science. He also serves on numerous corporate and civic boards in the United States, Asia, and Africa.</p>
